COMPETITION STRUCTURE

Round Robin and team with most Wins. (Wins - 2 points. Draw - 1 points)

If, at the end of the round robin, two teams are equal on points, then Goal Difference, then Head to Head to determine overall winner to qualify for NMR championships.

Teams must be off shortly after completing and the following teams ready to play at the scheduled time to ensure all fixtures games are played.

If a school is late to court then both teachers and umpire must agree to a time modification in the interest of participation. If a game hasn't started 10min after scheduled then the game is forfeited and points awarded.

PLAYING CONDITIONS

→ Matches to consist of 2 x 10 minute halves with 1 minute half time.

(4min court changeover)

→ 7 on court and up to 5 interchange players can be named for each game. Subs can be made during half time (no rolling subs).

→ Teams will need to be warmed up and ready to take the court at the scheduled times.

→ Umpires are provided All students, teachers, officials and spectators must abide by the [SSV Code of Conduct](#).

BOYS/MIXED TEAMS

→ ***A girl cannot play in a girls' team and a boys/mixed team*** in the same sport within the same calendar year.

→ A minimum of one Boy must be on court the entire game.

→ Team sheets are reviewed.

SCHOOLS NEED TO PROVIDE

→ One Size 5 Netball

→ Netball Team Bibs (2 sets to avoid clashes).

→ **A Person to operate the Scoreboard**

DRESS

- Jewellery removed - religious items that cannot be removed need to be sufficiently covered.
- Long hair needs to be tied up - Head scarves must be tucked in.
- Players must be in the same bodysuit/skirt/shorts (no pockets) with contrasting bibs.
- Finger nails should be taped or cut.

RULES

Netball is conducted under the rules of the All Australian Netball Association unless otherwise stated. Further information can be found in the SSV Primary Schools Resource Manual.

FIRST AID

Schools must bring their own first aid and trained staff for first aid on the day. There will also be a First Aid contact stationed onsite.

Schools must bring their own ice packs to the event. If required, schools must bring their own students epipens and asthma kits to the event. Schools are responsible for their own student's anaphylaxis and asthma equipment.

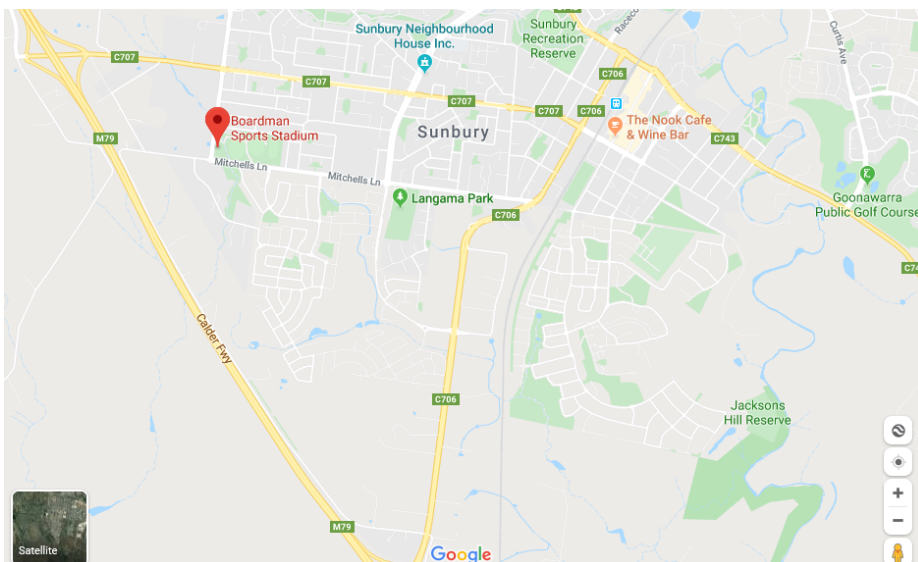
