Student Council

Student council represents the official voice of the student body and serves to address student ideas and concerns with the school administration. Elected as well as appointed officers serve one-year or two-year terms on the student council and meet weekly at lunch (and as needed). Through their work on the council, officers develop as school leaders and learn about their own strengths and areas for growth as they carry out the responsibilities of their offices.

Student council elections are held in either April or May for all offices except those for the 9th grade co-presidency, which occur in September. Candidates for all offices must be students in good standing with the school, and elected officers must continue to maintain the required standards of eligibility found in Article IV of the Student Council Constitution found on the Student Council Google Sites page.
