Spring M-STEP Testing

Each spring, all students in grades 4th-7th participate in the State Assessment known as M-STEP. All grade levels at the middle school complete the English Language Arts and Math assessments. Please make sure your child arrives at school on time and gets plenty of rest. Math testing will take place **this week** on May 6 and 8. Students will be asked to place these items in their lockers during testing (cell phones are always stored in lockers). Once testing begins, if a student has one of these items, the student's test and the tests of others in the room could be invalidated.
