All Staff Communication

Last week we sent out an all staff communication when the camp was set up to help keep our staff supported and informed.

Members of the LUU Leadership team are continuing to meet on a daily basis to share information and agree on any actions or checks on staff or students welfare.

This week we are aware that the camp will likely be a meeting point for a protest which is taking place on Tuesday 7 May at 6pm and for the weekly student walkout which is taking place on Wednesday 8 May at 1pm. If you feel affected by these events please speak to your manager or a member of the People team for support.

Protest groups have come into LUU's building on two occasions this year and we have put in place guidance and procedures to ensure the safety of our staff and students in such an occurrence. The main guidance for all staff is that you should not intervene if a protest happens in your area. You can stand and observe or you can make your way to the Inclusive office to get out of the area. Having a central place to go will ensure we know where all staff are located. The People Team will be available for support Monday - Friday 9-5.

LUU team members are continuing to do daily wellbeing checks on the students in the camp as we did for the previous occupation. The wellbeing of both staff and students always remains our top priority, and we are committed to ensuring students can make their voices heard in a safe and respectful environment within our community.

LUU currently has three **Staff Networks** and they are


