History:

Acquired as part of a deal with local allies in the 98Q “superpocket”, the Tsilo Extraction Facility underwent minimal renovations to perform its new role as a dedicated income tool for the pilots and allies of I-RED. Initial design plans for the structure were kept intentionally bare bones. However, repeated attacks from Serpentis Corporation subcapital and capital forces throughout its period of operation forced the hands of the I-RED Directorship. Throughout YC120, the Athanor underwent numerous tactical upgrades in order to bolster its ability to defend itself from future attacks from either Serpentis or hostile capsuleer forces. Now it stands ready to better defend itself, and the coveted ores it extracts from the valuable moon it orbits.

Features of Note:

Kanan Distillery: Uniquely and oddly placed, is the Kanan Distillery, a brewery established within the facility from the previous owners. An entire silo tower is dedicated for this distillery to produce its beer products, and upon purchase of the structure I-RED leadership opted to leave the distillery in operation even after the considerable renovations that took place throughout YC120. I-RED has allowed the original owners of the distillery to maintain ownership rights of their products and their operations. Most famous of their line of products is Loparocker™, an alcoholic beverage which supposedly contains flecks of loparite in the blend. Loparocker™ is commonly consumed in the 98Q superpocket, and less so outside the area. Some consumers claim it tastes like liquid money, while others find the taste repulsive.
