## **CAS Practicum Application Script**

## Verbal script:

When students are asking organizations for a possible placement in person or over the phone, they should introduce themselves in the following manner:

My name is (student name), and I am a CSUF Undergraduate student in the Department of Child and Adolescent Studies. I am currently enrolled in a class that requires me to secure a hands-on learning experience in a setting that involves either infants, children, adolescents, and/or families. I would like to complete a minimum of 60 hours of practicum experience, supervised by a person with a bachelor's degree or higher in a related field. Could you please tell me if there are any opportunities available and, if so, how I would go about applying?

This statement helps to make it clear that you as a CAS practicum student NOT in an observation role (i.e. EDEL 315 or SPED 371). Remember that if you are taking other classes for observation, etc. the hours cannot be used for both (no double dipping hours) and it is best to be in a different position with a different supervisor for each respective class. Keep in mind that you need a supervisor who can spend at least 30 minutes per week with you to guide and provide feedback in either a setting that is one-to-one or a group of other practicum students.
