Level	Responsibility	Focus Areas	Examples	Purpose
State-Level Standards	Establish and maintain statewide academic expectations. Support districts with implementation of standards and assessment.	Defining learning outcomes for all grade levels.	Standards in Math, English Language Arts, Science, and Social Studies; state assessments	Ensure consistency and equity across districts.
District-Level Standards	Adapt state standards to align with community priorities.	Customizing benchmarks to local needs.	Emphasis on cultural relevance, integration of local history or languages, and supplemental subject areas.	Bridge state expectations and local implementation.
District-Level Curriculum and Instruction	Develop and implement instructional materials and practices.	Classroom instruction, teacher preparation and support.	Curriculum maps, lesson plans, scope and sequence documents, pacing guides, professional development sessions, coaching, textbooks, and digital resources.	Deliver effective education that meets standards and supports diverse learners.
