
Order 1:

- *Harry Potter and the Sorcerer's Stone* (Like New \$4.25) This was pretty much like new. The only complaint that I have isn't with thriftbooks, it's simply that the dustjacket is slightly off where a normal person wouldn't notice it (but I do).
- *Harry Potter and the Chamber of Secrets* (Very Good \$4.53) This would have been better labeled as "like new" because it matches the other two books in quality and is basically new.
- *Harry Potter and the Deathly Hallows* (Like New \$8.46) The edges were slightly bent, but otherwise, it was in *perfect* condition. Honestly, if you told me this book had never been read, I would believe you.

- Harry Potter and the Prisoner of Azkaban (Very Good \$6.97) This would be a like new book. So, I opened the package and saw that it was a scholastic reprint, not the original. Upon emailing customer service, I was given a full refund and did not have to return the book. Their customer service was prompt, and the entire ordeal was solved within half an hour.
- *Harry Potter and the Half-Blood Prince* (Very Good \$6.97) There are about two to three dog-eared pages, and there is a bend on the spine of the dustjacket, but otherwise, this book is in perfect condition.


