



Dear Panther Families,

We want to start the new year on the right foot by reminding everyone about our uniform policy, with a special emphasis on the **importance of wearing all-black shoes**.

We value your feedback from last year regarding uniform enforcement. As we strive to create a professional and cohesive learning environment, we ask that all students adhere to the dress code. Please ensure that your child's shoes are entirely black, including laces and soles. This small detail helps create a sense of unity and upholds the standards we take pride in at our school.

Shirts & Outerwear

- Green or white Ivy Hill Prep polos should only be worn with Ivy Hill **black** or **khaki** pants, not with jumpers.
- Undershirts may be worn under the IHP polo. Scholars may wear an IHP **cardigan** or **fleece** sweater. If choosing to wear a cardigan, parents are strongly encouraged to write their scholar's name in the cardigan's tag.
- No jackets, scarves, gloves, etc. are permitted to be worn during the school day except where mandated by legitimate religious requirements.

Pants, Skirts & Jumpers

- Ivy Hill Prep logo Khaki jumpers should **only** be paired with a Peter Pan blouse.
- **Khaki** or **black** pants are the only pants permitted to be worn.
- Scholars can wear their Ivy Hill Prep sweat suits on Fridays **only**
- Scholars are required to wear the sweat suit top and bottom **together, as an item**.
The sweat suit cannot be worn separately

Shoes

- **100% all-black (lace & sole), closed-toe shoes or sneakers.** Boots are permitted, however they must be all black. Flip flops, sandals, and heels are not permitted.
- **Kindergarten Only: All black Velcro/no lace shoes are preferred for scholars who cannot tie their shoes.**

Jewelry

- Earrings may only be worn in ears. Necklaces may be worn but will be tucked in if they



serve as a distraction for scholars. Jewelry including but not limited to watches and bracelets may be worn but will be placed in backpacks if they serve as a distraction for scholars.
