1. The World

- a. Creation Story: (Description in 1-3 sentences)
- b. Map Creation: (Draw or download a template, save as example)
- c. Planetary Details:

2. The Continent

- a. Landscape: (Outline landscape ideas or jot down generalities)
- b. Climate: (Outline Climate around or jot down generalities)
- c. Countries & Regions: (Mark borders by rivers/landscape, etc. Overview of regions that might be allied)

3. The Country

- a. Country Origin Story: (Describe in 1-3 sentences how the country came about)
- b. Define Cities/Regions/City-States: (Mark on the map or outline a few important cities and regions in your country, no more than 2 paragraphs or 7 cities/regions)
- c. Government & Population Density: (Compare to real life examples, choose government and then density depending on all items thus far.)
- d. Culture & Society: (Take at least 2 different cultures & societies of the past or present and push them together to describe your overall theme. Work off of this.)
- e. (OPTIONAL) Landmarks & Geography: (Add landmarks and important geographical markers that have a history. Build no more than 5 per country to start.)

- f. (OPTIONAL) Plots, Rumors & Relations: (Pick 2-3 items of interest such as political scandals, rumors about the country or relations to other countries/regions.)

4. The City-State

- a. Local History: (Describe in 1-3 sentences the most important local history/origin)
- b. Define City vs. Country Side: (Define what type of city life and country life is. Like farm, ranchers, miners for country and metropolis, middle class, etc. for city)
- c. Trade & Commerce: (Define the goods that make the city thrive and why. 1-3 sentences)
- d. Class & Station: (Define the poorest, richest, and middle class along with why.)
- e. Family & Education: (Define the highest level of education, how accessible it is, and what family structure looks like)
- f. Morals & Religion: (Define the reigning religion and the standing morals that most share)
