- 2. PLAN: Plan your days based on the round (game) times and schedule below:
  - a. \$wiss G/45 d5<sup>2</sup>:
    - i. The round times are: 12pm, 2pm, 4pm & 6pm
    - ii. Notation during the game is mandatory
  - b. Scholastic (kids) u1400:
    - i. Time Control: G/25 d5<sup>3</sup>
    - ii. Quads: 9am to ~11:30am
    - iii. Notation during the game is not mandatory, but recommended.
    - iv. A chess clock if you have one
      - Come as you are if you don't have a chess clock.
      - Chess clocks are required if either or both players have a chess clock.
      - Chess clocks will be on sale at the Help Desk
      - The tournament directors may place a chess clock on any games that are not progressing on schedule.
