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ABSTRACT — *Abstract is written in Indonesian (and/or can be added with English) with single space. INTRODUCTION *(Cambria, Bold, size 12, Space 1,0)*

The introduction contains the purpose of the article/research which is formulated and presented with an adequate introduction and avoids detailed references and presentation of research results. The urgency of the research, the facts and supporting data should be included. The results of the preliminary research should be explained as the basis for the research. Before mentioning the purpose of the study, the gap analysis should be explained. Gap analysis expresses the difference between research and previous research. At this point, the novelty will be obvious. The attitude of the research should be included, whether it is correcting, debating, or supporting previous research. *(Cambria, size 12, Space 1.0)*

I. PAGE FORMAT

The easiest way to meet the requirement of writing format is by using this document as a template, and then type your text into it.

Page size must fit the A4 page size, which is 210 mm (8.27") wide and 297 mm (11.69") length. Margin limits are set as below:

- Top = 23 mm (0.90")
- Bottom = 18 mm (0.70")
- Left = right = 13 mm (0.51")

Article writing must be in two-column format with a space of 7.1 mm (0.28") between columns.

II. PAGE STYLE

All paragraphs must be well organized and must be justified, meaning that the paragraphs must be aligned evenly along the left and right margins.



REFERENCES

References in the article should cite the last name and year. If quoting from several authors, it must be sorted based on the latest references. If quoting from an article written by two authors, then all the names of the authors must be mentioned. Meanwhile, if quoting from an article written by three or more authors, it is quoted by writing the name of the first author followed by et al. The citation should be written in the references section. Any references cited must be written in full in the references section. Unpublished references are not recommended to be cited in the article. References must be written according to APA style. This journal requires that 80% of the references cited are from national and international journals. References cited are at least 20 pieces and a maximum of 5 years behind (*Cambria, size 12, Space 1.0*)
