Все зависит от страны, в США, к примеру, позволено провозить 10 тыс. долларов не декларируя их.

Будьте с этим очень внимательны и лучше уточните всю необходимую информацию заранее.

На этот вопрос тоже стоит отвечать конкретно: тысяча, две, пятьсот денежных единиц и так далее.

На этот вопрос отвечайте твердо: «I packed them myself».
