



# SCPS Specific Material Objection Form

## Part I:

1. Parents should make any material objection in writing to the principal of the school in which the material(s) is being used, identifying the specific instructional or other material issues, stating the specific basis for the objection, and providing evidence in support of the objection.
2. The principal will review the objection and may meet with the teacher or parent/resident, or both, in an attempt to resolve the objection, which may involve issuing alternative material(s) for the student.
  - If the objection is not resolved by use of alternative materials for the student or is an objection to the general use of the material, the parent/resident will complete this form for the principal to conduct a formal review.
  - If the objection is not resolved to the parent/resident's satisfaction, the principal shall forward this form to the Deputy Superintendent for review. The Deputy Superintendent or his/her designee(s) shall review the objection to evaluate whether use of the material should be discontinued in accordance with Florida Law.
  - If a concern is not resolved by the school district due to the objection process not being followed as outlined and in accordance with po2025 a parent may request the Commissioner of Education to appoint a special magistrate to render a resolution.
