



Logging into Google Classroom

****How do I log into Google Classroom*** Student:

- 1. The teacher must add the child to the class.
 - a. This is done by the teacher sending an email invitation to the student who must open the email and accept the invitation.

OR

- b. The teacher gives the student a code (either by email, in person or during a virtual meeting. The student must go to Google.classroom.com, click on the + sign in the top right of the screen, choose Join, and enter the code.
- 2. Once added to the classroom, the student can log in as below.

Parent

- 1. The parent can view the students progress in 1 of 2 ways:
 - a. The parent can log in using the student's Ichabod Crane Username and Password to see the classroom the same as their student.

OR

- b. The parent can be added to the classroom by the **teacher** as a "Guardian"
- c. The teacher would email them an invite and then they can then receive updates from Google Classroom.

With a Guardian Summary, parents can see the following:

- Missing work—Work not turned in when the summary was sent.
- Upcoming work—Work that's due today and tomorrow (for daily emails) or that's due in the upcoming week (for weekly emails).
- Class activity—Announcements, assignments, and questions recently posted by teachers.






***In order for the following to work, the student (or the parent) must be logged into Google with the student's **Ichabod Crane Google Account**

1. Type in: classroom.google.com in the URL bar of Google Chrome



Or...

2. Click the 9 dots on top of Google and then click on the Classroom Icon



Find your Classroom, or your child's Classroom and click on it to open the Classroom
