This iconic San Francisco event brings together thousands of students, professionals, and families for a day of jaw-dropping sand sculptures, live music, food trucks, and community fun – all in support of arts education for Bay Area students.

The 44th Annual Sandcastle Classic, a San Francisco tradition, raises funds for high-quality arts and architecture education for nearly 8,000 Bay Area students who would otherwise go without. Thousands flock to Ocean Beach to see teams of local elementary students and professionals from over 100 architecture, design, engineering, construction, and tech companies collaborate to build enormous, intricate sandcastles.

This year's theme, **"Bay Area Vibes"**, celebrates the music, art, culture, and architecture that make this region unlike anywhere else in the world! From iconic landmarks and natural landscapes to legendary sports teams and a vibrant local arts scene, we encourage teams to bring the spirit and creativity of the Bay Area to life on Ocean Beach this fall.
