Position Overview:

Indigenous Education is seeking six (6) student interns who are current Sophomores, Juniors, or Seniors enrolled in Indigenous Education with ASD who are at least 16 years old. Interns will provide instructional support for elementary and middle school students participating in the Indigenous Education Summer Enrichment Program. The program is designed to assist Alaska Native and American Indian elementary and middle school students in scholastic proficiency through academic and cultural enrichment activities. This year's theme is "Salmon Streams and Strength".

Responsibilities:

Student Interns will:

- Assist in the preparation, facilitation, and wrap-up of the Summer Enrichment Program.
- Support the Cultural Instructor in monitoring and engaging students in small-group learning activities (approx. 25 students per class).
- Follow daily schedules and responsibilities as assigned by the Program Coordinator.
- Participate in orientation, training, and cleanup sessions before and after the program.

Work Schedule:

- Regular Program Hours: Monday Thursday, 9:00 a.m. 4:00 p.m.
- No work on: June 19, 2024 (non-work day).
- Orientation & Setup: May 28-30, 2025 (10:00 a.m. 5:00 p.m.).
- Cleanup Day: Friday, June 27, 2025 (9:00 a.m. 1:00 p.m.).

Qualifications:

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Must be currently enrolled in Indigenous Education with ASD.
- Must be a full-time student at an ASD school or a recent graduate (Class of 2025).
- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Must have a **cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher** (unofficial transcript required).
- Must have a creative, dynamic, and hands-on approach to working with younger students.
