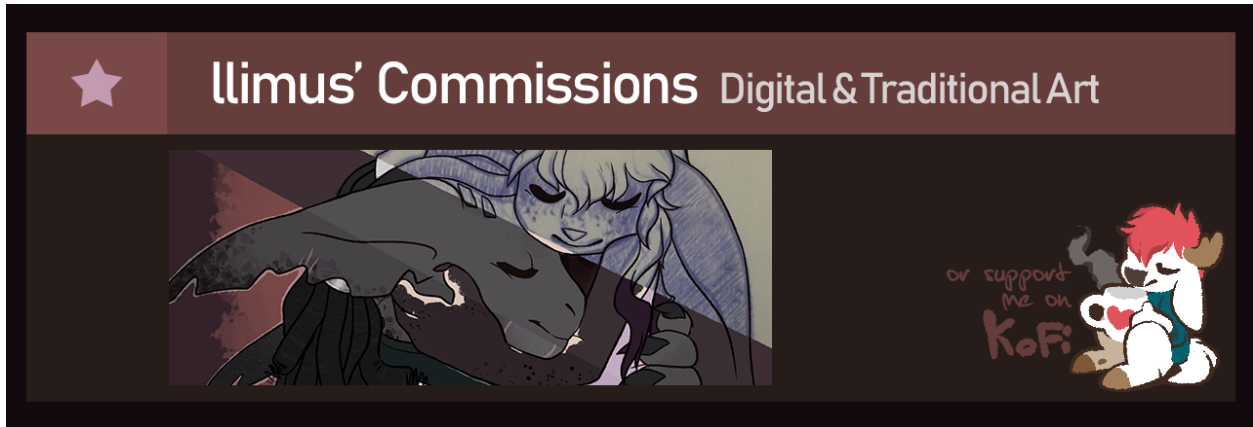

Commission Info

General

Things I will draw:

- Normal animals or anthropomorphized animals/furries.
- Human/humanoid characters.
- Fandom content (Pokémon, *Guild Wars 2*, etc).
- Original characters.

Things I won't draw:

- Sexual or "Not Safe for Work" (NSFW) content.
- Hard gore.

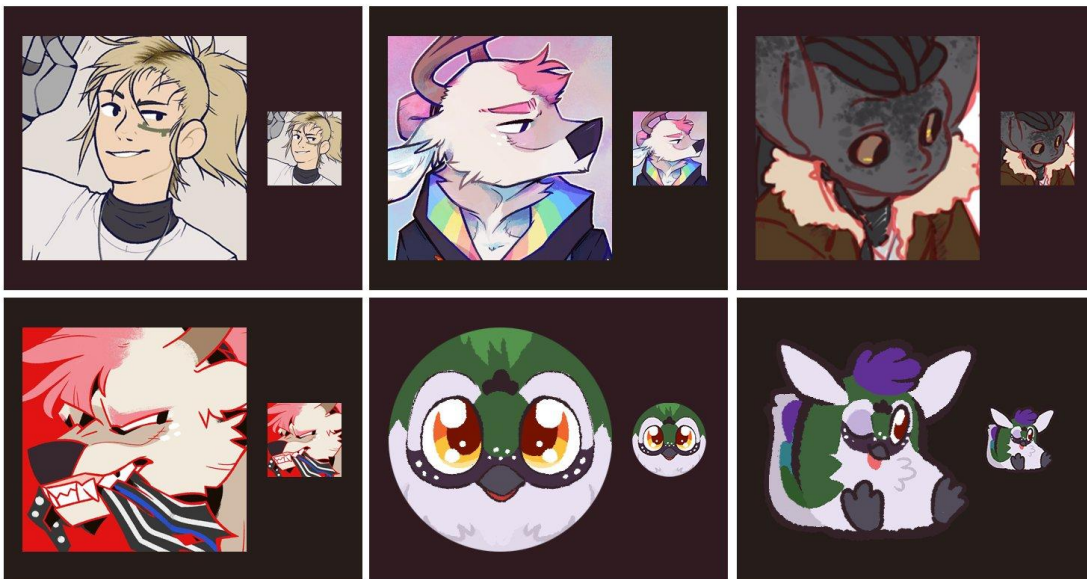
Things I won't draw: (continued)

- Offensive or discriminatory content, especially that which is harmful to an oppressed or vulnerable group of peoples.

Prices

All prices listed out are a commission's starting price. Pricing is based on, generally, price-per-character. There may be additional costs added for things like complexity and quality including, but not limited to: multiple characters, detailed characters, armor, characters with extra limbs, etc. Additionally, the finished quality will affect prices (sketch vs lineart vs flat colors vs shading).

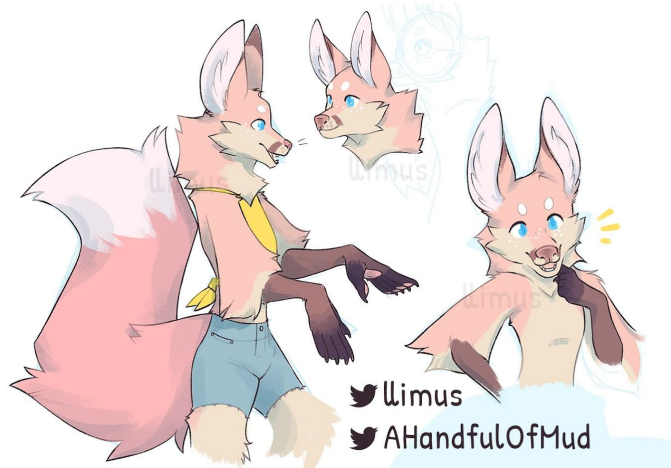
Icons - \$50/ icon



Icons start at **\$50** for a single icon. I can do pairs or matching icons. Several examples posted above.

Icons are generally between 500px and 1500px on a square canvas. Transparency can be included and icons do not need to fit or fill the entire canvas if you don't want them to.

Sketch / Sketchpage - \$40-80/ each



Sketches start at **\$40** for single sketches. Fullbody sketches start at **\$50**.

Sketchpages start at **\$80** for a single sketchpage. Several examples are posted above. Sketches and sketchpages have no color at base pricing but color and shaded can be added in for a fee.

Character Drawing - \$50-100/ each



Character Drawings have several different price points. These are lined, flat-color pieces featuring a character as either a headshot/bust, halfbody, or fullbody outlined below:

- **Headshots** or Busts start at **\$50**. Busts include the head and shoulders of a character.
- A **Halfbody** starts at **\$75**. Halfbodies include a character in view from the head down to about the waist.
- A **Fullbody** starts at **\$100**. Fullbodies include the entire character in view.

Terms of Service

General Practices & Policies

For the purposes of this outline, “commissioned work/s” may also be referred to as “order/s”, “finished work/s”, “piece/s”, “commission request/s” and “commission/s”.

Please keep in mind that I can only do pieces in my own style. I will not match other artist’s personal styles and I cannot properly emulate artistic styles that are wildly different from my own, although I will be happy to draw inspiration for your commission from general styles such as travel posters, pop culture, etc.

Also keep in mind that you are ordering a digital, non-tangible good from me through this service.

Submissions of references must be Safe For Work (SFW) / **Rated G - PG13**.

References that don’t fit these guidelines will be refused and your request may be cancelled.

Rights & Usage Policies

I, the artist, reserve the rights to the work or works produced, completed or not. I also reserve the right to refuse service to anyone.

This means that I am allowed:

- to share and post the finished work on social media.*
- to include the commissioned work in my portfolio, on my website(s), and in any material and posts promoting myself, etc.

*I will happily consider requests not to share finished works on social media, however it must be requested before or upon completion. I cannot remove posts that have already been made.

This means that I am allowed: (continued)

- to reuse refused/rejected sketches, poses, or concepts in future works.

I am not allowed:

- to claim ownership or rights to your character/s or intellectual property.
- to use the final work in merchandise production (such as prints) without prior agreement.

You, the commissioner, reserve the rights to your character and IP.

You are allowed:

- to use the finished commissioned work for any personal use (i.e. profile picture, social media icon, twitter banner, etc.).
- to print for personal use.
- to make minor edits for personal use (i.e. resizing or adjusting pieces for a social media icon)
- to repost, with proper credit, the finished commissioned work.
- to use & repost with non-monetary self-promotion with proper credit

You are not allowed:

- to use or reproduce the finished commissioned work for commercial use, including but not exclusive to: printmaking, advertising, & merchandise production.**
- to remove, cover, or crop my signature or watermark out of the image when reposting it.
- to edit the commissioned work extensively.

Payment, Cancelling, & Refunds

**Commercial opportunities may be discussed separately. Be aware that terms, pricing, and payment will likely change.

1. Payment is required in full before the commission request can be started. If a payment plan is arranged prior, progress will be completed incrementally as payments are made. As stated above, requests of mid- or large-scale edits to a piece past the sketch or lineart phase may incur a fee which must be paid first in order to make changes or finish

I do not accept trades or merchandise as payment. All prices, payment, and invoices will be in **USD**. At the moment, I can only accept payment through **PayPal**.

★ A note on **KoFi**: I do not and will not accept commissions through KoFi itself. My KoFi (ko-fi.com/llimus) is a tipjar for donations only.

★ Payment plans may be arranged, although I do not take them often. Contact me and ask about one in regards to your order if you need to.

2. Cancellation of an order/request by **you, the commissioner**, may result in a cancelled invoice if payment has not been received or a refund as defined below in Part Three of this section. Cancellation of an order/request by **me, the artist**, will result in either a cancelled invoice if payment has not yet been received, a full refund if work on the piece has not been started, or partial refund if work on the piece has been started.

Cancellation of a commission by you, the commissioner, **before payment** incurs no fee. Simply inform me directly (via email, twitter dm, etc.) that you need to cancel your piece and I will remove you from the queue and cancel your invoice.

Cancellation of a commission by you, the commissioner, **after payment** is covered in the "Refunds" section below.

**Commercial opportunities may be discussed separately. Be aware that terms, pricing, and payment will likely change.

3. Refunds are handled by me. By issuing a refund through Paypal and not contacting me, you will be blacklisted and will not be able to place an order with me again. If, at some point before your commission is finished, you need to request a refund, contact me as soon as possible by email or Twitter.

In the event that payment has been received but I, the artist, have *not* started on your commission, I can process your cancellation/refund request with a fee of 5%.

In the event that payment has been received but I, the artist, have *already* started on your commission, I can only process your cancellation/refund request for **up to 50%** of what you paid. In some cases, I may not be able to provide you with a refund.

I do not issue refunds for completed commission requests. My fees are for my efforts and time spent and I try to work with my commissioners to make sure they are happy with their order.
