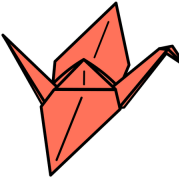
### FALL CLUB INFORMATION

- We will have a **CMS Club Activity Fair** on **Wednesday, September 30th** in the Commons from **3:00-4:00 p.m.** We encourage all students to come to see the Fall and Spring club offerings.
- Club sign-ups will be held virtually **beginning on Wednesday, September 30th** and **ending at the close of school on Monday, October 5th at 3:00 p.m.**
- **Students participating in a team sport or Intramurals during the Fall, should not sign up for a Fall club.** A team sport involves a Monday through Friday commitment. Intramurals will count as a student's Fall Club.
- **If a seat is not available for one of a student's top three choices of clubs in the Fall, they will be prioritized for the Spring.**
- Rosters will be generated by a random lottery using all names on the sign-up sheet. It will be important for students to select their three different top choices. If seats are available, they will be assigned **one** of the three. Students will receive an email notification of their club sign up status on **Friday, October 9th by 6:00 PM.**

## Once students are informed of their Club for the Fall...

- Make sure your child calls you if they are staying after-school.
