To Parent/Guardians of incoming freshman at Brewer High School in the Fall of 2025,

This letter is to inform you about some of our important athletic information and dates that you and your child will want to be aware of as he/she transitions from their 8th grade class into their freshman year at Brewer High School.

Of note, and immediate need, your child will need a **NEW physical examination** performed prior to participating in athletics at Brewer High School. You will find a copy of the Brewer School Departments physical form within this packet. *Students without a new physical on file are not permitted to set foot on a practice facility until this requirement is taken care of.* This policy is strictly enforced by the coaches and administration at Brewer High School. On page 5 is a flyer to an easy way to access sports physicals through our school-based health center contracted through PCHC.

Additionally, you will find a directory of coaches for the 2025-2026 school year and some summer programming information for those programs that offer activities. *Summer programs are provided voluntarily by members of the coaching staff. These are optional for your child to attend as many, or as few of each sport session as your family can fit in to your busy summer schedules.*

All information regarding summer programs and fall athletics can be found on our website, www.gobrewerwitches.com. Under Brewer High School, you will be able to find schedules, contact information and summer programming information under the appropriate sport listing. Please note- these schedules and information packets are likely still "in the works" as of the end of May and should be finalized soon. Also, you should REGISTER YOUR CHILD for their fall sport ASAP!!

Additionally, each fall program will hold a parent and student-athlete informational meeting prior to, or immediately following the **August 18th start date** of Fall 2025 athletics. Please keep your eyes and ears posted for more information regarding the parent and athlete nights being offered for fall programs.

So you are aware, all incoming freshmen enter Brewer High School with a "clean slate" academically. Your child is immediately eligible to participate in athletics, regardless of their academic standing at the conclusion of the 2025 school year.
