

Proyecto: La cultura por la ropa
Español 312

You and a partner will create a PowerPoint presentation (alternative: poster) about an assigned unique type of clothing from the Hispanic world, and will present it to the class.

Your presentation will include the following information *en español*:

- what your item is (¿un vestido? ¿sombrero? etc.)
- where people wear the item (include a map)
- who wears this item (¿hombres, mujeres, muchachos, todos?)
- when it is worn (¿todos los días? ¿un día de fiesta especial?)
- what it costs (if this information is available)

Your presentation should have at least three pictures of the item. The in-class presentation should be five to ten minutes long.

In addition, your presentation will explore a *cultural connection* as specified in the assignment sheet, e.g. bullfighting for the *traje de luces*. This part of the presentation should teach something to your classmates and should be adequately illustrated.

You cannot do this whole project by keyword searches! We will be spending two class periods in the library, during which library staff will help you use on-line databases like CountryWatch, and also printed resources, to do your research. You must use at least two such sources and document them, along with any keyword-found sources that you use for more than just images, in a bibliography.
