## Computer

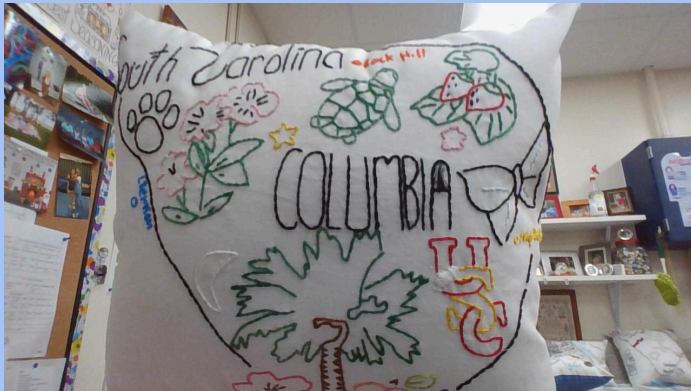
Animation students will be applying animation principles to animate animation exercises starting with pendulums.

Computer students are finishing up with learning their keys for typing. Then we will move onto code.org

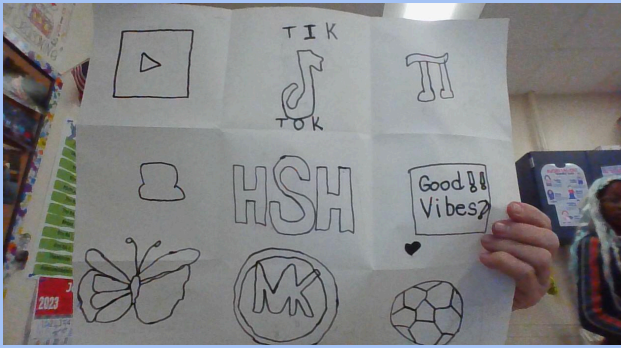
## Family and Consumer Science 8th gd:
