FIRST WEEK OF SCHOOL!

Hello Preschool Families!

It was so great to meet so many of you at Meet Your Teacher last week. If you didn't make it, we'll have your items ready at drop off for the first day of school! If you haven't filled out the preschool packet yet, please do that now. We need this filled out before students can attend class.

REGISTRATION PACKET: HERE

If you missed orientation or need a refresher, read the notes and watch the replay HERE.

REMINDERS:

- School starts on Wed, Sept 3rd and Thurs, Sept 4th.
 - o The first day is a TUMBLE day for all classes.
- Be sure to send your child's bag to school every day! If you missed bag pick up, we will have it for you on the
 first day.
- Students can be dropped off no more than 5 minutes before their start time. Plan to drive around the building and teachers will meet you at the north end of the sidewalk to help unload your child.
- Pull through pick-up is the last 10 minutes of your class. If you need a reminder about pick up, watch the tutorial video below. Mon-Thurs classes are 3 hours long, so if your class starts at 9am, your pick-up window is 11:50-12pm. Please have your car nametag visible. If you are early, please wait in a stall in front of the building until your pick-up window begins. Be sure to bring your pick up tags each day. If you do not have your pick up tags, we will need to see ID.
