Confession/Lament

As I've considered our present predicament (each of us being stuck inside our own homes for months at a time without any real face-to-face contact), I've rarely felt **hope**less, but I've often come to this feeling of **help**lessness.

I've often wondered if there is anything in the Bible that speaks to it. Is there anything in the Bible that speaks to a group of people who literally cannot see one another face to face.

The thing that I keep coming back to is how Paul would write letters to people that he couldn't physically see, although he would long to see them. He talked about this all the time. It was something that he deeply lamented.

In Romans 1:11, Paul puts it like this:

[11] For I long to see you, that I may impart to you some spiritual gift to strengthen you

In 2 Timothy 1:4, Paul says this:

[4] As I remember your tears, I long to see you, that I may be filled with joy.

And then in Philippians 1:3-5, Paul puts it like this:

[3] I thank my God in all my remembrance of you, [4] always in every prayer of mine for you all making my prayer with joy, [5] because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now.

Paul is no foreigner to longing to be with those that he loves. Today, we cannot gather in person, but we all long and yearn for the day when we might be back together.

Assurance

For me, I fear that God will not build his church during this time. This is something we say all the time, but it's good for us to remember, but this is God's church, and he's going to build it. That means that I don't get to have the church that I want, but the church that God wants.

He gives us two sweet promises as continues the letter to the Philippians:

[6] And I am sure of this, that he who began a good work in you will bring it to completion at the day of Jesus Christ.

It's so good to know that though I might feel helpless and distanced, God is going to continue to do his work in each of your hearts.

And he continues in v. 12:

[12] I want you to know, brothers, that what has happened to me has really served to advance the gospel

Paul is talking about being locked up in an isolated prison cell. If God can use that to advance his gospel, he certainly can use the coronavirus to advance the gospel!
