

Required Basic Items to Get Scouts Ready for Car Camping:

The Outdoor (Ten) Essentials

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| ☐ Pocketknife (if scout has Totin' Chip) | ☐ Personal First aid kit w/blister care |
| ☐ Rain gear (rain jacket or poncho (rain pants are optional)) | ☐ Sun protection (sunscreen 30 spf+ and hat/wide brimmed hat) |
| ☐ Trail food (personal snacks for in between meals) | ☐ Map & compass (map will be provided as required) |
| ☐ Headlamp (w/1 set extra batteries) | ☐ Matches & Fire starter (if scout has Firem'n Chit) |
| ☐ Extra clothing(1 synthetic/wool/moisture wicking shirt, 1 pair socks. *no cotton) | ☐ Water bottle (* recommended 1 liter Nalgene or other appropriate container filled) |

Additional Items beyond 10 essentials

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| ☐ Right size day pack (~20-25L) | ☐ Class A Uniform (travel to and from scouting activities): shirt, belt, neckerchief, closed toed shoes |
| ☐ BSA Handbook with pen/pencil | |

- ☐ Sleeping pad - foam encouraged, or inflatable (recommended three season and R value 3+)
- ☐ Light weight jacket/outer garment
- ☐ 2-person tent w/ground cloth and stakes (there are troop tents to borrow or your tent

buddy may have a personal tent to use on campouts)

- ☐ Camping mess kit/utensils (plate/bowl, fork/spoon, and cup)

Recommendation beyond the Ten Essentials:

- ☐ Insect repellent
- ☐ Whistle
- ☐ Watch
- ☐ Camp Chair

- ☐ Sunglasses
- ☐ Hand sanitizer
- ☐ Paracord (50ft) (optional)
- ☐ Bandana

DO NOT BRING:

- ☐ Electronic Games
- ☐ Other Non-essential items
- ☐ Illegal Items
