- It's great to focus on what else can be done in a second term, but most of the public isn't aware of what Biden has already done. How do make sure the public is aware of Biden's successes and that those successes are imperiled if he doesn't win re-election?
- How do you balance the tension between giving the administration a low grade when they disappoint and praising them in an election context.
- Can you talk more about your partnerships with community-based orgs? How do you identify groups with whom you're working to tell these stories? What does partnership look like?
- So very many experts in the field of climate/overshoot and the polycrisis now agree we are in rapidly accelerating unstoppable all systems collapse of global industrial civilization....tho it's vital to do everything we can as with this initiative, but within realistic parameters....despite all the advertising that we can "fix"this, it's too late to prevent collapse but we can focus on building resilient community, locally and nationally and globally... Your response please and thanks for this good work
