Grading Guidelines

- Second graders are assessed with the following grading scale: 100-90 A, 89-80 B, 79-70 C, 69-60 D, and below 59 U. [GRADE WEIGHTINGS](#)
- For all subjects, daily grades, quizzes, weekly tests, unit tests, and projects are recorded in the grade book and are designated as a major or minor grade.
- Major Unit Assessments will be given at the end of the unit study.
- Second graders receive grades in Language Arts, Math, Science, and Social Studies.

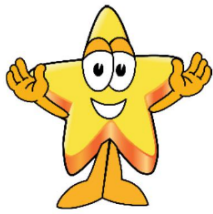
Classroom Expectations

Homework

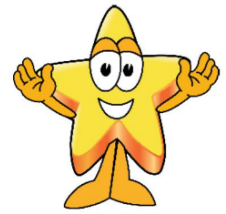
Students will have a nightly reading log to fill out. They need to read for 10-15 minutes every night and parents will sign off on their reading. An optional additional homework
