



2018 Terragena Chardonnay

Abbassi Vineyard

Chardonnay with bright acid, complex aromatics, and a persistent finish, all hallmarks of this Noble grape. Transplanted from its origin in Burgundy to the Carneros region of Sonoma County, these low yielding, 40+ year old vines produce wine with floral and fruit aromatics of pears, stone fruit, and daffodils while young. Expect the wine to mature with these fresh notes and other aromas of honeysuckle, cinnamon, and caramel as it ages gracefully over the next 10+ years.

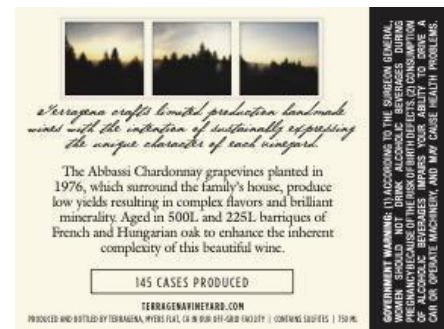
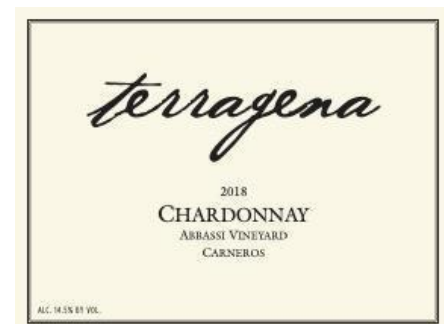
