- 5.) diligent, Adjective: characterized by steady, earnest, and energetic effort
- 6.) confound, Verb: to throw (a person) into confusion or perplexity
- 7.) acute, Adjective: characterized by sharpness or severity of sudden onset
- 8.) audacity, Noun: intrepid boldness; bold or arrogant disregard of normal restraints
- 9.) profound, Adjective: having intellectual depth and insight
- 10.) <u>sagacity</u>, Noun: the quality of having keen and farsighted penetration and judgment
