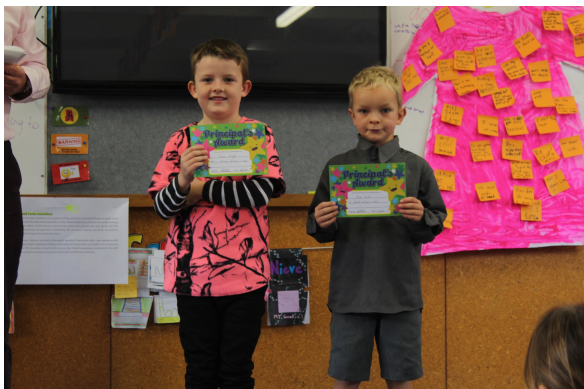
Our 'Pink Day' on the 20th May was very well supported by staff and students, we had a great day at school as you would have already seen on our Facebook page.

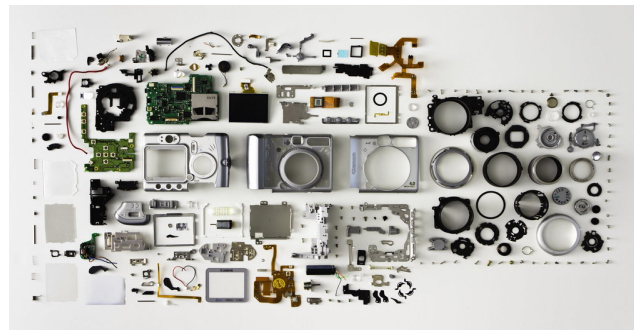
