Douglas MacArthur was under command of the United Nation Forces. After Korea split into communist and democratic, North Korea invades South Korea and almost takes it over. The United Nations managed to not let it be taken but the Chinese started helping North Korea and there troops stayed at the 38th parallel. North Korea invaded South Korea in June 1950.
