1. Principals Updates - After Trunk or Treat- Very well attended. Sent out information to district admin about success. We had many volunteers participate. A true community event. 450 kids counted. 600 tickets for food handed out, but there were more than 700 total in attendance.

a. Sign- Met with Everywhere Signs on 11/5 to see what new sign options are, next steps? - Back of building would be one sided sign. Reached out to Sam Fleener for sign update, but Dr. Winston has asked the district to halt sign projects at the moment. Reached out to Adam Terwilliger as well in the business office about funding, but we still aren't sure what that will look like.

We will await further information. Will still get quotes so we can know what we are looking at in case it is still a possibility.

b. Fairview merch forms and info reminder (Kelsey) - Forms are coming in daily, we have 25-30 currently. Will ask teachers to send a reminder on parent square. Friday is the deadline for ordering.

Ms. Abshier asked about having ongoing stock. Mr. Biggs noted that we will hope to have a stockpile for next year.

Ms. Tobey shared has an update about Print on Demand merch, will come back later in meeting.

2. President's Update #1 -

a. Trunk or Treat - Overall successful event! Feedback for next year? -Worked out well to ask families to donate candy. PTO didn't have to buy any. - Ms. Norris noted the Pizza order was perfect. Mr. Gobert noted that we should have similar attendance next year as we have now added all ALPS classes we ever will.

Ms. Schlegel noted that the food for teachers was really nice to have available. Shared leftovers the next day.

Mr. Biggs noted pizza prices will most likely go up next year. Discussion about adding another food option. Most likely will remain just a slice of pizza and water.

Mr. Biggs discussed the need for a photo backdrop that will work in any weather. Maybe a grommeted banner that we can attach to things.

b. Raising Canes D&D 10/30 - went well? - Ms. Crigler went, but didn't see anyone else from FV. Will ask Mr. McGee about how much we gained.

f. Teacher Encouragement (Lisa*) - 3 teachers have won high five's and were

given prizes. Teachers are excited for the recognition from staff and students. Ms. Abshier is working on getting \$10 gift cards. We can give gift cards to Ms. Pierson.

Mr. Biggs proposed a vote on keeping this a tradition. All members voted yes.

*Ms. Norris brought up the Target gift cards we give to teachers and staff each year. Our donor will not be providing funds for this any longer. - We will need around 75 this year. Discussion about giving equal amounts to all staff vs. Teachers getting more than support staff. Mr. Biggs likes the idea of giving a standard amount. Ms. Black suggested \$25 each for everyone. Ms. Tobey added that teachers were split between Target and Amazon. Ms. Norris made a motion to pursue \$25 for all staff. Ms. Schlegel seconded. Ms. Tobey asked about community artists. We have not traditionally given them a gift card. Target gift card deal will happen around the 6th or 7th of December

i. Teacher Appreciation Lunch - 11/5 McCallister's delivery (Jennifer) - Big thanks from teachers. Ms. Black sent out instructions to staff to order from McAllister's with same date and time. Everyone used Fairview as their last names so orders would be grouped. 10 teachers ordered. Look out for order ahead options from other restaurants.

ii. Thursday, November 20th as our date for the Pie Bar (Julie) - Ms. Hood noted we will just do sweet pies this year. We are going to try to get all pie donated from families. Will send out a notice on parent square and social media. - Can also donate money for PTO to donate. Ms. Norris asked about allergies. A few teachers are gluten free, so we will pay attention to that and be sure to have something for them.
