A common link does not mean that the results are not personally identifiable. If the student completes the survey from their laptop, they are personally identifiable. Unless the district is able to delete the individual records of each survey, the answers are identifiable.

Would you answer a different question? Does the CT Data Privacy law, Sec. 10-234cc give Google permission to use the data collected on students to provide recommendations in their search engine for education or employment searches? It would appear that it does. If so, Google is able to use sensitive personal information in their search algorithms.
