

Guest Wi-Fi Internet Usage Policy (Acceptable Use Policy)

By accessing and using the **Standing Rock Community Schools Guest Wi-Fi network**, you agree to the following terms and conditions. This network is provided for temporary, guest use only.

1. Acceptable Use

You agree to use the Guest Wi-Fi network in a lawful, responsible, and ethical manner. Use of the network must comply with all applicable local, state, federal, and international laws and regulations.

2. Prohibited Activities

You may **not** use the Guest Wi-Fi network to:

- Engage in any illegal activity or violate any laws or regulations
- Access, transmit, or store content that is unlawful, harmful, threatening, abusive, defamatory, obscene, or otherwise objectionable
- Attempt to gain unauthorized access to any systems, networks, or data
- Introduce malware, viruses, spyware, or other malicious software
