*Volunteers needed to help with the egg hunt





You can purchase the book on Amazon, however it is not necessary for participation.






January's diaper drive brought 1,094 baby and adult diapers, as well as other incontinence products for our neighbors in need.

All Items can be placed in large trash bags tied up and dropped off in the Goat Barn in the parking lot behind the church at 73 Old Highway 28. The doors to the barn will be open during daylight hours from March 13-27, 2021 There will be a separate bin for donations of pantry items, cleaning products or hygiene products such as laundry detergent, shampoo, soap, paper towels, deodorant, razors and shaving cream.
