1. Graduate Success on the NCLEX Licensure Exam

Expected Level of Achievement:

The program's annual licensure examination pass rate will be 80% for all first-time test takers during the same 12-month period.

The three-year mean for the licensure examination pass rate will be at or above the national standard.

The national standards are as follows for students passing NCLEX on the first attempt:

2. Program Completion

Expected Level of Achievement:

- 45% of students who begin the first nursing course will graduate on time as defined by SVCC and VCCS (4 semesters).
- 55% of students who begin the first nursing course will graduate from the program within 150% of the time frame as defined by SVCC and VCCS (6 semesters).
- Three-year data reflects that 60% of graduates from each location will complete the program within 150% of the program length.
- Students are calculated based on attendance after the drop date with a full refund.
