College Vocational Program (A101)

Do you have an Intellectual Disability or identify as neurodiverse and are looking for support in preparing and transitioning to the workplace?

The **College Vocational** one-year certificate program is for students who identify mild intellectual disability or neurodiversity as a barrier to being successful in the workplace. Our inclusive program will help you develop your skills in the areas of communication, teamwork, self-awareness, self-advocacy, and give you the confidence to achieve your goals.

This program is suitable for those who have graduated from high school with an Ontario Secondary School Certificate (OSSC) or Diploma (OSSD) and workplace credits.
