

Using Paper with a Substitute Teacher Any Subject, Grades 3-12

Assignment Objectives

• Students will be able to utilize Paper Live Help and a graphic organizer to better understand confusing concepts and skills taught in class while with a substitute teacher.

Teacher Instructions

- 1. Print this resource for when you are absent to understand what concepts and skills your students were confused with while learning with a substitute teacher.
- 2. In your substitute lesson plans, be sure to inform the substitute that students can utilize Paper when they get stuck on any of the work that is assigned.
- 3. Each student will use the Paper Live Help feature and the attached graphic organizer to take notes on the concepts taught in class in which they needed more assistance with.
- 4. Collect documents from students when you return and remediate if you feel necessary.

Ideas for Use

- 1. Best used to collect data on the concepts and skills that students did not understand while with a substitute.
- 2. This resource can also be used for any homework assignments over long breaks or weekends to identify the areas in which students are struggling.

Student Instructions

- 1. While learning with a substitute teacher, use this graphic organizer to write down all of the problems you were struggling with when completing the assignments.
- 2. Login to Paper and start a Live Help session to review all of the problems that you did not understand.

Example Conversation Starter: "Hi! I'm working on this question in class assigned by my substitute teacher, and I'm not sure how to correctly answer it."
