Caches Everywhere!

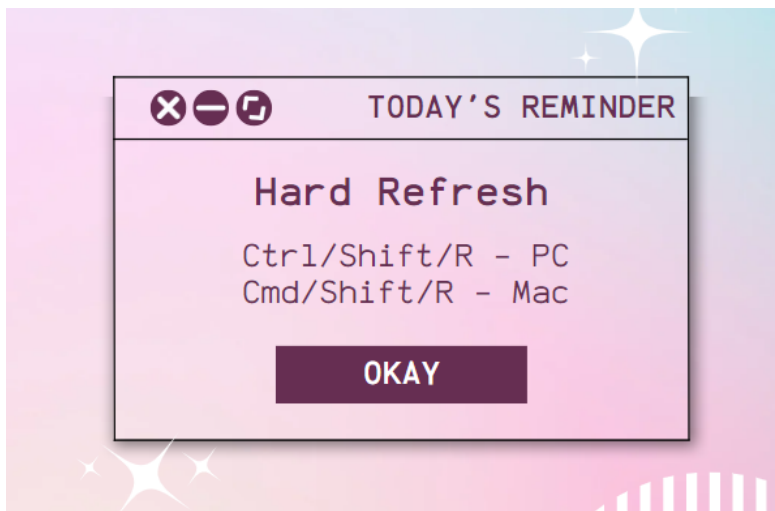
Clear your cache is definitely something you have heard before . Today the spotlight is on the Google cache. You are probably affected by the Google cache every time you are working in Google Chrome without even noticing. My guess is that is exactly the user experience Google wants. However, the Google cache does affect the SEEDS experience once in a while.

The Google cache can cause what feels like a delay in the following functions:

- Student is marked as Eval in Process - Yes.
- Student is changed to Eval in Process - No, Special Education - Yes.
- Student is added to a class list.
- Student is added to an itinerant list.
- Student is newly added to SEEDS.

Google's cache remembers your "view" until it refreshes every few hours. That is when it updates your view to include these student changes. You do have choices, though. You can:

- Be patient and check back in about 2 hours.
- Log out of SEEDS and log back in.
- Log out - Hard refresh - Log back in



"Extra" Students

Do you ever wonder why you are seeing "Extra" Students on your Student Search screen? If a student is marked as "Eval in Process," it means that anyone in the district is able to view the student during the term of that evaluation. This allows all staff who need to participate in the evaluation to access that student.

Use the "Filter by Eval in Process" to remove those students from that student screen. Reports filtered by class list or itinerant list will also exclude those "extra" students.

Always use professionalism and only access students assigned to you.
