1. What Data We Collect

Our extension ("Calorie Counter | Food Tracker") processes the following data solely for the purpose of recognizing and tracking calories in meals:

- **Uploaded Images**: Photos of food that you provide via the extension.
- Recognition Data: Calorie estimates and other nutritional information extracted from the uploaded images.

2. How Data Is Processed

Images:

- The photos you upload are processed by the extension to identify food and estimate calories.
- Uploaded images are securely sent to OpenAl API for recognition and processing.
- Images are stored on our secure server to allow you to view your meal history within the extension.

Recognized Data:

- Nutritional data (e.g., calorie estimates) extracted from the images is stored on our server.
- This data is used to display your meal history and provide tracking features.

3. What Data We Do Not Collect

We do not collect or store:

- Personal data such as your name, email address, or IP address.
- Any additional personal or browsing data unrelated to the core functionality of the extension.

4. How OpenAl Handles Your Data

All uploaded images are processed through the OpenAl API. OpenAl may temporarily store data during processing but adheres to strict privacy and security policies. You can review OpenAl's policies for more details:

5. Permissions

The extension requires the following permissions to function:

- File Access: To allow you to upload food photos for calorie recognition.
- Network Access: To securely send photos to OpenAl and retrieve recognized data.

- Uploaded images and recognized data are stored securely on our server.
- Your meal history is accessible only through the extension and is not shared with third parties.

7. Your Consent

By using our extension, you consent to the processing of the data you provide as described in this Privacy Policy.

8. Third-Party Services

We use the OpenAl API as a third-party service for image recognition. No other third-party services are involved.

9. Security

We take data security seriously:

- Images are transmitted over a secure HTTPS connection to the OpenAl API for processing.
- All stored data is protected with encryption to ensure your information remains private.

10. Your Rights

You have the right to:

- Request the deletion of your uploaded photos and recognized data stored on our servers.
- Uninstall the extension if you do not agree with this policy or want to stop using it.
