



Eye Protection for Prescription Glasses Wearers

Current Regulations

All PRL lab spaces require safety glasses. As of April 2023, people who wear prescription eyeglasses need to use additional eye protection; safety glasses that can be worn over normal glasses will be available to borrow in the lab.

Note: Side shields added onto your existing prescription glasses does not meet the current regulations

Prescription Safety Glasses

Cost: ~\$95 (including lenses)

Cost: ~\$35

3. [RX Safety](#) (Comes in single vision, lined bifocal, progressive bifocal)

Cost: varied (~\$30+)
