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## Budget Updates

The California Legislature passed a budget in June 2021 with significant impacts on our work:

- A commitment, with funding, to reach Universal Transitional Kindergarten by 2025-26.
- Significant new resources for teacher training and retention, including \$125 million to fund the Classified School Employees Credentialing program.
- \$100 million to support hiring more community college full-time faculty.
- The extension of the hold harmless provision through 2024-25 to delay the full implementation of the controversial community college Student Centered Funding Formula.
- Apprenticeship investments, including:
  - RSI this year is going to be \$6.77 per instructional hour, this represents a 4.05% cost-of-living adjustment and then some, as it is up from \$6.44.
  - CA Apprenticeship Initiative budget is doubled to \$30M for 2021-2022
  - As predicted there is also a significant investment of \$25M in High Road Training Partnerships with a call out to creating new partnerships that include Community Colleges and Apprenticeships.
- Child care expansion funds
- Significant expansion funds for After - School Programs and the creation of a new program
- Additional funds for teacher outreach
- Proposed changes in testing requirements for future teachers ( pause on CSET and CBEST and alternative options)

Additionally, the Federal Child Care Tax Credit is rolling out and federal funds for child care, community college training programs, apprenticeship expansion, and ongoing federal discussions on student loan forgiveness, tuition reduction for college students, federal support for child care facilities and COVID relief proposals all must be monitored. It is both an exciting and confusing time to be in the ECE/EDU sector. Stay informed and follow legislative announcements and policy press releases.
