Here are some choices for the week! **Social Emotional Learning:** Choose one or more Mindfulness Make a glitter jar for Mindfulness ■ You can use a mason jar, a spice jar, or even a plastic water bottle for this practice. First, fill the jar with water. Then, add glitter. Be sure to use glitter that sinks rather than floats. Other options since glitter can be messy include using different colored beads, sequins, or a mix of food coloring and oil. Seal the jar with its lid or duct tape. Ask your child what kinds of things will make the glitter in the jar swirl. Encourage answers that reflect both challenging events (fights with siblings, losing in sports) and positive ones (getting a good grade, making a new friend). ■ This jar when it is shaken represents what can happen in our minds when we are feeling overwhelmed, frustrated, upset, angry, excited, etc. or a combination of feelings. Once we are able to use various strategies, like calm breathing, taking a walk, or talking about our feelings, our minds feel calmer. This is when all the glitter in the jar settles and the water is clear again. Connectedness Play a board game with a family member. Board games are also a great way to practice social skills, including taking turns, cooperating, winning and losing, etc. It can be helpful to have more than one person on a team so that your children can practice taking turns and working cooperatively with a team member.
