

Lilly of the Valley

- **Stamp Set:** Lilly of the Valley (167937)
- **Card Stock and Paper:** Blackberry Bliss (133675); Granny Apple Green (146990); Fresh Freesia (155613); Basic White (166780); Valley in Bloom 12 x 12 DSP (167935)
- **Stamp Pads:** Fresh Freesia (155611); Garden Green (147089); Blackberry Bliss (147092)
- **Tools:** Lilly of the Valley Dies (167942); Floral Spray 3D Embossing Folder (167946); Stampin' Blends: Granny Apple Green (154885); Stampin' Cut and Emboss Machine (149653)
- **Miscellaneous:** Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430)

Measurements:

- Blackberry Bliss CS: 8½" x 5½", scored at 4¼"; 5¼" x 4"
- Granny Apple Green CS: scrap for leaf die
- Valley in Bloom DSP: 2½" x 4"
- Fresh Freesia CS: 1" x 4"
- Basic White CS: scrap for flower die; ¾" x 4"

Instructions:

1. Crease the Blackberry Bliss CS to form cardbase. Emboss the smaller Blackberry Bliss CS with the Floral Spray 3D Embossing Folder. Adhere to the cardfront.
2. Tear the top and bottom of the Valley in Bloom DSP to expose the white core of the paper. Adhere to the cardfront.
3. Stamp the flowers in Fresh Freesia ink on the Basic White CS scrap and die cut. Use the Dark or Light Granny Apple Green Stampin' Blend to color the stems. Adhere to the cardfront (you may need to trim the stem.)
4. Stamp the leaves in Garden Green ink on the Granny Apple Green CS and die cut. Add Stampin' Dimensionals to the tops of the leaves and liquid glue at the bottom and attach to the cardfront.
5. Stamp the sentiment in Blackberry Bliss ink on the Basic White CS strip. Adhere it to the Fresh Freesia CS. Attach to cardfront using Stampin' Dimensionals.
