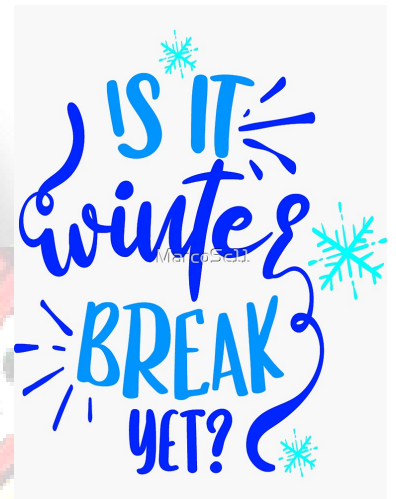
ADD/DROP CLASSES: Any student who would like to add or drop classes for next semester must do so before December 20th. Please see Mrs. Robison during your study hall times.
