Let's see the steps to follow this method.

Step 1: Open the RUN dialogue box. This can also be done using the shortcut WIN+R.

Step 2: To open the Software Reporter tool, type "%localappdata%\Google\Chrome\User Data\SwReporter"

Step 3: This will take us to a version number folder that has the **software reporter tool.exe** file.

Step 4: Select the .exe file and click on the **Delete** key.

This method is a stop-gap arrangement. The reporter tool will reappear as soon as Google Chrome updates to a newer version.
