

# Are you Hungry? - 10 June 2018

BIG Point: I am created for more.

God's Words: The Calling of the First Disciples (Mark 1:16-20)

Memory Verse: "Come and follow me," Jesus said. "I will send you out fish for people." (Mark 1:17)

Life Question: What am I hungry for? Does it last forever?

### Kids spot

#### Intro

Welcome children and start by asking children if they remember what they learnt on Sunday. Quick recap by reading the Memory Verse together.

## **Activity & Discussion**

We are always hungry? We ate at least 3 meals a day and sometimes, we ate more than 3 meals a day. God wants us to hungry for him, God wants us follow him. Just like Peter, when Jesus called Peter to follow him, Peter put down all things & follow Jesus.

What are you hungry for? Food? Books? Clothes? Money? Toys? Friends? Will you follow Jesus follow and hungry for him? How do you know you are hungry for him? Food is the most important. Physical hunger is so consuming that we cannot think of anything else until it is satisfied.

Jesus used the legitimate craving of the body for food to describe a deeper hunger the hunger of the soul for God and the longing for eternal life.


In Matthew 5:6, Jesus taught, "Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be filled." The word translated filled means fulfilled or satisfied.


**Gospel Connection**: This passage is important to the gospel because we see Jesus work a miracle and then teach his new disciples what their life will be like as fishers of men. The men were unable to catch any fish until Jesus came and they listened to him. Jesus then tells them

that they will be fishers of men. Their ministry, like their fishing trip, will be completely dependent on Jesus' will.
