Greetings WSWSU Families, Faculty, Staff, and Community,

As mentioned in my last communication, all students and staff, regardless of vaccine status, will remain masked indoors unless entitled as a matter of law to an exemption. This masking expectation has been approved by each of the WSWSU district boards. I also want to share that since my last letter, the Agency of Education (AOE) has recommended that we identify our own additional COVID mitigation strategies to ensure the safety of all students and staff. To this end, I have reviewed the recommended protocols from the Center for Disease Control (CDC), the Vermont Department of Health (VT DOH), the Vermont Agency of Education (AOE) and the American Pediatric Association regarding how best to ensure the safety of all students and staff, and have used them to create the WSWSU COVID-19 Mitigation and Reopening of Schools Plan Fall 2021, with the assistance of the COVID-19 Taskforce (made up of principals, administrators, and nurses).

The Following Guiding Principles Informed the Plan

- The safety and health of all students and staff are our first priority.
- The social and emotional well-being of students and staff is essential.
- Equity of learning opportunities is front and center in everything we do.
- In-person, full time education is our focus.
- Current advice from the CDC, American Pediatric Association, VT DOH and the VT AOE will inform all decision-making.
