Local Northeast Portland activist, author, and photographer Richard Brown's 2021 book, *This Is Not For You*, talks about the decades of activism working to better the community included, but not limited to, advocating for changes to policing and police training. Richard was the chair of the Hope and Hard Work committee which met weekly to address community issues in NE Portland. He led the eighteen month long Beech Street community watch in which 7 days a week for 5 hours per day community members walked Beech Street between MLK and Albina to build community and promote safety.
