# What to do if you can't find your confirmation email from Mobilize America

If you have signed up for an event on Mobilize America and cannot find your confirmation email, here is what you can do to locate important information about your event that was included as part of the confirmation email that you were supposed to receive, but, for whatever reason, did not.

#### Step 1.

Go to: <a href="https://mobilize.us/dashboard/">https://mobilize.us/dashboard/</a>. If you are not already logged in, you should be prompted to enter your email (as pictured below), and you will receive a one time sign in link.



## Step 2.


The email you are looking for is called: "Your login link for Mobilize."






### Step 3.

Once you have logged in, just click the circle on the top right side of the screen and select: "My Volunteer Schedule."




Here you will find all of the volunteer events you have signed up for.
